BENEFITS QUICK REFERENCE CHART

Available Benefits	Legal Authority	Who may receive the benefit?	Limits
Burial Expenses	16-3-1180(A) (5)	*Claimant who contracts with the funeral home and is responsible for the bill	\$4,000.00
Medical Expenses	16-3-1180(C)	*Victim requiring medial services resulting from a crime	Maximum benefits \$15,000 if resulting from a crime extraordinary circumstances exist and are documented, victims may apply for additional funding.
Counseling Expenses	16-3-1180(A) (1)	*Victim of a crime with physical or emotional trauma *Claimant who is an immediate family member/survivor of a homicide case	Up to 180 days from first charged session or 20 sessions (whichever is greater)
Lost Wages	16-3-1180(A) (3)	*Victim currently employed at time of crime	2/3 of average weekly wages up to \$15,000.00 compensation maximum
Loss of Support	16-3-1180(A) (3)	*Claimant may request Loss of Support when it is medically/emotionally necessary to be absent from work to care for a minor child	2/3 of average wages up to the \$15,000.00 compensation
Mileage	16-3-1180(A) (3)	*Victim/claimant who must travel more than 5 miles one way to visit the doctor, counselor, or physical therapist	Current mileage rate at time of the incident
Sexual Assault	16-3-1350	*Victim of sexual assault or child abuse	SOVA pays according to fee schedule. Victim and insurance company are not to be billed.
